

Declaration of Safety and Conformity

We herewith confirm that the products we manufacture and their packaging comply with the requirements set out below.

I. Compliance with the REACH Regulation

On 28 October 2008, the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) published the first Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) and has updated it regularly since then.

We hereby confirm, to the best of our current knowledge, that the products we manufacture and their packaging do not contain any substances from the current ECHA Candidate List in concentrations exceeding the statutory information threshold of 0.1 per cent by mass.

We are complying with our duty to provide information in accordance with Article 33 of the REACH Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 and will inform our customers without delay should any substances on the Candidate List be present in concentrations exceeding the applicable threshold in future.

II. DGNB Compliance

We hereby confirm that the products we manufacture and their packaging meet the requirements of DGNB certification for the relevant product groups. In particular, based on our current knowledge, we confirm compliance with the requirements regarding:

in accordance with the applicable requirements of the DGNB system.

III. Absence of (H)CFCs and (H)HFCs

We hereby confirm that no halogenated or partially halogenated chlorofluorocarbons ((H-)CFCs) or hydrofluorocarbons ((H-)HFCs) are used in the manufacture of the products and packaging we supply.

IV. Compliance with heavy metal requirements in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR)

We hereby confirm, based on current knowledge and on the basis of the raw material information, product specifications and supplier declarations available to us, that the products and packaging we manufacture comply with the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR) regarding heavy metal content.

The sum of the concentrations of the following heavy metals

- Lead (Pb)
- Cadmium (Cd)
- Mercury (Hg)
- Hexavalent chromium (Cr VI)

does not exceed the limit value of 100 mg/kg for packaging and packaging components.

V. Statement on PFAS (per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances)

We hereby confirm, based on our current knowledge and on the raw material information and supplier declarations available to us, that no PFAS (per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances) are intentionally added to the products and packaging we manufacture.

Furthermore, we are currently unaware of any evidence indicating the presence of PFAS in the raw materials or products we use.

Should new information regarding the composition of the raw materials used become available in future, or should the legal requirements change, we will inform our customers accordingly.

VI. General Note

The above statements are based on the current information available to us, raw material data sheets, supplier declarations and technical documentation.

This statement does not constitute a product specification but serves as evidence of compliance with the aforementioned legal and standard requirements at the time of its issue.
